



Trailblazer COVID-19 Guidelines

Our top priority is the health and safety of our visitors, staff, and community. TAME utilizes guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to ensure our museum on wheels remains a safe, clean, and healthy place for everyone to play and learn.

We have adopted a number of enhanced health and safety measures to help ensure the safety of our guests, volunteers, and staff.

Preventative Procedures

TAME is eager to bring the Trailblazer to your community. To ensure we maximize engineering exploration and mitigate the impact of COVID-19 on the health of our community, we are:

- Cleaning & disinfecting high-touch surfaces in-between visits from different groups (e.g., classrooms within the same school) with safe and efficient disinfectant.
- Weather permitting, keeping doors open to support the flow of fresh air through the Trailblazer. We have air purifiers with high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filters to enhance air cleaning.
- Monitoring local conditions and have a flexible rescheduling policy: if the requesting community or TAME staff have been exposed, TAME will reschedule the visit to a future time, at no additional cost.

Day of Trailblazer Visit Guidelines

Please read carefully as these guidelines are very important and must be adhered to during a visit from the TAME Trailblazer.

- Trailblazer capacity will be adjusted depending on COVID levels in the community using COVID levels reported by [CovidActNow.org](https://www.covidactnow.org).
 - If levels are classified as LOW, Trailblazer visits will be implemented at 100% of capacity and a maximum of 30 visitors can be in the Trailblazer at one time.
 - If levels are classified as MEDIUM, Trailblazer visits will be implemented at 50% of capacity to prevent overcrowding and promote appropriate social distancing. A maximum of 15 visitors can be in the Trailblazer at one time.
 - The Trailblazer will not visit areas where the COVID levels are classified as HIGH.
- All visitors, staff, and volunteers will be asked to sanitize their hands when entering the Trailblazer.
- Per CDC guidelines, it is recommended that all staff, volunteers, and visitors ages 2+ wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth while in the Trailblazer. We have plenty of masks for you!
- Please maintain social distancing whenever possible while inside the Trailblazer. Even at reduced capacity, there may be periods where certain exhibits are crowded. Staff may temporarily limit access at those times to minimize contact between groups.
- Disposable child-size and adult-size masks are available.
